1. New Cases are for the period 5-8 December 2020.
2. Data for some countries for the number of tests conducted are often not continuously updated and should be used with caution.
3. For The Bahamas, the number of deaths in the table includes 24 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 35 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 222.
4. For Jamaica, the number of deaths in the table includes 31 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 38 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 335.
5. There is a lag (4 days) in the reporting of data on Haiti, 2 days for The Bahamas and 1 day for Bermuda.
