4. For Jamaica, the number of deaths in the table includes 15 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 9 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 150.
5. There is a lag (2 days) in the reporting of data on Haiti.
6. The latest figures reported by Guyana might be a mix of data for 6-7 October.
7. Data for the Bahamas and Barbados have been updated for 6 October.
