## **NOTES:**

- 1. New Cases are for the period 3 -6 October 2020.
- 2. Data for some countries for the number of tests conducted are often not continuously updated and should be used with caution.
- 3. For The Bahamas, the number of deaths in the table includes 13 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 19 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 134.
- 4. For Jamaica, the number of deaths in the table includes 15 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 9 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 150.
- 5. There is a lag (2 days) in the reporting of data on Haiti.
- 6. The latest figures reported by Guyana might be a mix of data for 6-7 October.
- 7. Data for the Bahamas and Barbados have been updated for 6 October.
