## **NOTES:**

- 1. New Cases are for the period 24 -27 October 2020.
- 2. Data for some countries for the number of tests conducted are often not continuously updated and should be used with caution.
- 3. For The Bahamas, the number of deaths in the table includes 17 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 27 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 180.
- 4. For Jamaica, the number of deaths in the table includes 30 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 14 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 242.
- 5. There is a lag of 3 days in the reporting of data on Haiti and 1 day for Barbados and Bermuda. At the time of publication of this bulletin Saint Lucia's death increased by 2 to 67.
