NOTES:

- 1. New Cases are for the period 31 October 3 November 2020.
- 2. Data for some countries for the number of tests conducted are often not continuously updated and should be used with caution.
- 3. For The Bahamas, the number of deaths in the table includes 25 deaths that are under investigation and excludes another 29 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 203.
- 4. For Jamaica, the number of deaths in the table includes 28 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 16 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 259.
- 5. There is a lag (3 days) in the reporting of data on Haiti and 1 day for The Bahamas, Barbados and Bermuda.
