NOTES:

- 1. New Cases are for the period 26 -29 September 2020.
- 2. Data for some countries for the number of tests conducted are often not continuously updated and should be used with caution.
- 3. For The Bahamas, the number of deaths in the table includes 15 deaths that are under investigation and excludes another 15 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 125.
- 4. For Jamaica, the number of deaths in the table includes 10 deaths that are under investigation and excludes 6 deaths that are classified as due to non-COVID-19 causes. The total number of deaths of COVID-19 patients is 123.
- 5. There is a lag (3 days) in the reporting of data on Haiti. The 7-day average for the number of new cases is approximately 17.
